


There's one important number we have to leave open-ended: return on investment.


Because that number is simply so astronomical, we have no way to classify it






Her mother left the family to find work abroad. She sent money home ... but Evelina struggled with loneliness.

She lives in a tiny, rural village in Moldova, seemingly isolated from the rest of the world — until a church from a neighboring city invited her to a summer camp.

Evelina went and received her own *Hope for Kids* specialedition *Book of Hope*. It was created in partnership with Kids' Evangelism Explosion and helps children learn to share their faith.



In fact, Evelina received 10 more copies of the book, gave them to friends, and several started coming to camp with her.

"I didn't know anything about God before camp," Evelina says.

"After I read the book, I learned that God loves me. I prayed to God, and now I've started to become friends with Him."

Today, **Evelina is walking with Jesus**, and sharing her faith with her father and sister, too.

PROGRAM UPDATE: PATHWAY TO HOPE

By God's grace, the partnership with Kids' Evangelism Explosion is impacting children in dozens of nations!

Hope for Kids is the training program for Christian children that shows them how to use their special-edition Book of Hope to tell their friends about Jesus.

Pathway to Hope is the special-edition Book of Hope that Christian children share with their unchurched friends. At the end of their Hope for Kids training, each child receives 10 copies of the book with the goal of sharing the Good News with 10 of their friends.



IN 2018, THIS PROGRAM REACHED 3,977,400 CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

GOD'S WORD FOR CHURCH PLANTING


He didn't think it was wrong—
the village elders told him and
the other boys to harass the
team from a neighboring village—

The team had come to show *The GodMan* film, introduce young people to Jesus, and start a church. But in this majority Muslim region of Tanzania, the village leaders wanted them to know they weren't welcome!

Ali Juma was throwing rocks at the team during the film showing. He thought that's what the Muslim god would want ... but he couldn't help seeing the story of Jesus unfold on the screen ... and Ali Juma began to be haunted by what he'd done.

The next day Ali Juma found the team, confessed that he was part of the mob that had tried to stop the film showing ... and asked to know more about Jesus. He committed his life to Christ that day!

Please keep Ali Juma in your prayers ... his Muslim family disowned him because of his decision to follow Jesus. Thankfully, his new church family is helping to provide for him so he can stay in school.





PROGRAM UPDATE: HOSANNA PLAN

The *Hosanna Plan* is a church-planting initiative created to share God's Word with each of the approximately **100,000 cities, towns, and villages** that have not yet received the Good News and do not have a church in Russia.

By God's grace, and thanks to your prayers and generosity, more than 4,000 churches have been planted through the *Hosanna Plan*.

PROGRAM UPDATE: THE LUMIÈRE PROJECT

This multi-year, multi-nation project aims to reach six million children and youth with the Good News and help to plant more than 3,000 new churches in French-speaking Africa.

Many of these locations are remote villages plunged in the darkness of Islam and animism, at times openly hostile to anyone proclaiming the name of Christ. Pastors are traveling many miles on bicycles or motorbikes to bring God's Word to these villages. Other church planters are **following God's** call to urban areas where spiritual darkness is no less prevalent simply because people have access to modern conveniences.

GOD'S WORD FOR THE NEXT GENERATION CHILD

Mariana was dumb-founded by her friend Arisha's story—

Something about a Man who was also a God but who was executed on a cross and came back from the dead—"So now we all need to believe in Him."

To Mariana it sounded like a fairy tale—like Father Frost, the Russian equivalent of Santa Claus. **But they were big girls now and didn't believe in Father Frost!**





The next day, Arisha tried sharing her story again ... but this time, she showed Mariana the *Bible App for Kids* with the games and activities that told the story of Jesus ... And slowly, over the next few days and weeks as they played with the app together, Mariana realized: **maybe Jesus wasn't a fairy tale!**

Today, Mariana has committed her life to Christ!

She and Arisha are attending church together, and they remain the best of friends. And of course, they still love playing with the *Bible App for Kids* together, too!

IT'S CROWDED—BUT A COMMON WAY TO LIVE IN THE FAVELAS OF BRAZIL: the landlord

lives in the top story of his house and rents out the rooms of the lower level to several different families.

Vanessa lived with her mother and younger sister in one room of such a home, just a bed against the wall for all three of them, and all their belongings kept in a pile on the floor.

There were other children in the home, and at nine years old, Vanessa was the oldest, which made her feel entitled to act out and abuse the smaller kids. When her mother tried to get her to behave, Vanessa would become aggressive with her, too.

But then the social worker who came to the house to look in on an old lady who lived there, began talking to the children, too, and sharing Bible stories with them from the *Bible App for Kids*. Soon, seven children were meeting regularly to play with the app - learning memory verses, playing games, and even praying together.

Now, Vanessa has chosen to follow Jesus!

PROGRAM UPDATE:

BIBLE APP FOR KIDS



Last year, the *Bible App for Kids* was installed in **221 countries!**

By September, we celebrated the 25-millionth download — and by the end of **2018, we had already surpassed 26 million.**



In 2018, the *Bible App for Kids* added nine new languages for a total of 42 languages.




In his majority Muslim nation, Omer was brought up as a nominal Muslim, like most of his generation.

But he felt no real connection to Islam ... and wondered if God even existed. That's when he saw the ad on social media that was asking the same questions Omer was asking himself:

Where does my identity come from?
What are my values based on?
What happens when we die?
Why am I here?

He clicked on the ad and was soon receiving email lessons that gave him scriptural answers to these questions ... then he began emailing back and forth with a OneHope team member, who connected him with a church in his town ...



PROGRAM UPDATE: THE 10/40 WINDOW

2018 Reach: **52,784,680**2018 Active Countries: **68**

North Africa. The Middle East. Asia.

Countries in these regions — located approximately between 10 and 40 degrees north latitude — are part of the rectangular area known as The 10/40 Window. These locations are often called "The Resistant Belt" that includes the majority of the world's Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists.

Originally, the 10/40 Window only included countries with at least 50% of their land mass within that 10 and 40 degree north latitude area. But the 10/40 Window has been revised to now also include several additional countries that are in close proximity and have high concentrations of unreached peoples.

GOD'S WORD FOR THE FRAGMENTED FAMILY

Their father abandoned the family. Their young mother was angry, fearful, bitter, and unable to cope with rearing her two sons alone — she became quick to abuse them verbally and physically.

Six-year-old Aurismar and his older brother Gabriel were brokenhearted and afraid

... until the local church reached out to them with a special-edition Book of Hope that helped the boys come to receive Christ as Savior.





THEY BEGAN TO PRAY


for their mother to choose Jesus, too. Their new church family surrounded them and prayed with them. They live in a nation on the *World Watch List* for the persecution of Christians, but the church proved to be a haven of peace and hope for Aurismar and Gabriel ...


And soon their mother began to attend with them!

SHE COMMITTED HER LIFE TO CHRIST, TOO.

Now she has a mentor from church who is helping her grow in God and as a mother, too. Today she has a new attitude of love and compassion for her sons — and their home is filled with peace and joy!







THERE WASN'T ANY SUNDAY SCHOOL — no Children's Church, no children's minister. The children were usually left to play outside while the adults had a service.

But then one day there was an incident: one of the kids threw a stick at a beehive. The angry bees swarmed after the children — who ran into the church with the bees following them! Almost everyone in the building suffered from bee stings that day.

That was it for Bongani. **He didn't go back to church anymore.** It was safer to stay home and watch TV than risk getting stung by bees!

He didn't know that their church had begun a new outreach to the neighborhood children, using OneHope Scripture engagement programs, until his older sister brought her *Book of Hope* home from church one day. He decided to go to church the next Sunday and check it out ... and was immediately drawn in to the *God's Big Story* program.

Each week he learned a new Bible story and received his own illustrated card — **now Bongani attends church every week** and is learning and growing in God!

PROGRAM UPDATE: GOD'S BIG STORY

Made up of 16 individual cards, *God's Big Story* is a unique program created by OneHope that uses individual Bible stories as well as the **metanarrative of the Bible** to reinforce the way each story in the Bible fits into the larger framework of God's "Big Story."



PROGRAM UPDATE: THE GODMAN FILM

A visual representation of the life of Christ, *The GodMan* film is adaptable to many outreach activities. From church planting in small villages to outreaches in schools and homes, *The GodMan* film is a well-loved resource that is reaching children and youth around the world with the Good News.

The GodMan film has been customized for ten different cultural worldviews. These contextualized versions feature live-action segments that bookend the animated Jesus story to address the specific heartfelt needs of children and youth in the target region.



Schools have suffered shortages of everything from books and school supplies to teachers, who often don't even show up for class if there's a hope they might be able to find food or other supplies in the next city.

No wonder Yoneiber felt there was no hope for the future. But then he saw our short film, En Tus Manos (In Your Hands). It showed how God's Word helped one young man find his way to faith in Christ and discover meaning for his life.

Yoneiber realized this was the hope he needed—and chose to **dedicate his life to Jesus Christ!**





GOD'S WORD FOR EVERY DAY OF THE YEAR

LIFE IS HARD IN THE ASIAN NATION WHERE MELE LIVES.

The population is one of the most youthful in Asia—because of high birth rates and low life expectancy. The traditional Eastern religion's influence is everywhere—even endorsed by the restrictive government.

But the tiny minority of Christians is bold enough to share the Good News with the next generation ... and this is how Mele came to know Jesus Christ. She was invited to a Christmas party and received a special-edition *Book of Hope*.

The joy this brought to her life can't be overstated!

Both of her parents are drug addicts. They're enslaved to addiction ... and to their traditional faith. They beat Mele and told her she couldn't go to church, but she remains faithful to her new friend, Jesus.

"My Sunday School teacher told me, when you are having any problem or trouble, call on Jesus Christ for helping," she says. "I DO PRAY TO JESUS ... PRAISE THE LORD! HE IS THE ONLY ONE TO HELP ME."




